At the end of the day, it was obvious that buying a new building in the city limits was not feasible at this time. A vote by the Nobles present decided that it was the best course of action to put off building the Temple and remodel the front of the barn for an Event Center that can be rented out for wedding and parties to create income. This area could also be used by us to have dinners and Shrine events and a place for the Ladies to gather while we retire to our meetings. The project is being discussed and design and construction will begin soon.

The Bowling event is coming up this Saturday at Town and Country Lanes. Details are posted in the Al Bedoosings. I intend to arrive early on the Temple property prior to the Bowling in order to begin to making plans for the construction of the Event Center. Now is the time for input. If you want to be involved meet me there with ideas and vision.

It's a very busy week around the Shrine office with Imperial deadlines for more paperwork and internal paperwork as well as a busy week for me wearing my other hat of a Pastor as yesterday was Ash Wednesday and this is the first week of Lent. All have worked hard on ideating and presenting suggestions that might produce some good income, but in the meantime we are planning on spending only earned interest and a modest building improvements fund that has been set aside.

We did vote last Stated Meeting to renovate the Black Horse Patrol (currently a defunct unit) barn into an events center. Income is envisioned through rentals (it is a beautiful location with splendid scenery) and at the same time add office space to the existing clubhouse/Al Bedoo Temple. We have renovated the house on property and it will be a good revenue stream through rentals. Moving the office to the Temple will save us monthly rentals and some dual services such as WiFi/internet and will also put us in compliance with Imperial's directive to have the office at the Temple location. All renovations and improvements will stay within our stated purpose of not touching the principal on our investments. Our Hospital Patient Transportation Fund seems to be well-funded and securely invested.

Sorry about all those nuts and bolts but it is information I believe you need to know. You also need to know that the discord seems to be gone and we are having fun in Brotherhood again.

Saturday we will be having a gathering to bowl together. More activities are planned for the future that are inexpensive and just designed for a fun time with lots of camaraderie. Please consider joining us. Al Bedoo is alive and well and always better with YOU!

# PC's Recipes



## Almond Joy Cookies

### Ingredients

- 1 cup butter
- 1 1/2 cups white sugar
- 1 1/2 cups brown sugar
- 4 eggs
- 3 teaspoons vanilla
- 4 1/2 cups flour
- 2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 5 cups chocolate chips
- 2 cups sweetened coconut
- 2 cups chopped almonds



### Directions

Pre-heat oven to 375°F Lightly grease cookie sheets.

Combine dry ingredients, set aside.

In a large bowl, cream the butter and sugars together. Beat in the eggs, one at a time, stir in the vanilla. Stir in the dry ingredients until well mixed then stir in the chocolate chips, coconut and almonds. Drop by rounded tablespoonfuls onto the prepared cookie sheets.

Bake for 8 to 10 minutes. Cool on baking sheet for 5 minutes before removing to a wire rack to cool completely.


